# WHAT IS WALKATHON?

## What happens on Walkathon Day?

- Students should wear good walking shoes and be dressed for the weather!
- Walkathon will only be rescheduled if stormy weather is forecasted.
- Students will be given a Walkathon T-Shirt on the morning of Walkathon to wear during the event.


